

## **Impact Statements**

- A <u>Complainant's impact statement</u> is a written statement describing the impact of the prohibited conduct and expressing a preference about the potential sanctions to be imposed.
- A <u>Respondent's impact statement</u> is a written statement explaining any factors
  that the Respondent believes should mitigate or otherwise be considered in
  determining the potential sanctions imposed.

## **Impact Statements Procedure**

- Both the Complainant and Respondent may submit impact statements to the Title IX Office within two business days prior to the live student conduct hearing date (Form in Maxient).
- Impact statements must be uploaded as an attachment and may not exceed more than three (3) pages.
- 3. The TIX Coordinator or their Designee will review and hold all impact statements until a finding of responsibility has been determined following the live student conduct hearing.
- 4. After the live student conduct hearing, <u>if there is a finding of responsibility</u>, impact statements will be shared with the hearing panel only for the purpose of identifying any mitigating/aggravating factors for the purpose of identifying sanctions and remedial measures.
  - a. The hearing panel chair must inform the TIX Coordinator or their Designee that a finding of responsibility has been identified and impact statements will be released to the hearing panel.
  - The hearing panel will review impact statements before identifying sanctioning.
- 5. After the live student conduct hearing, if there is not a finding of responsibility, impact statements will not be shared with the hearing panel.
