Torchiere style lamps that use a compact fluorescent or LED bulb are permitted. Flashlight & Batteries Power Strips Laundry Soap + Basket Digital Camera Steamer or Iron HDMI/Roku/Amazon Fire/Comcast → to have Philo on TV

What **NOT** to Bring

- **★** Extension cords and multi-plug adapters
- **≭** Portable space heaters

IN THE VITCHEN

- ★ Halogen lamps & halogen bulbs 300 watts or more
- ★ Appliances without automatic shutoffs (e.g. George Foreman grills)
- **★** Wall size tapestries

- ★ Non-LED holiday lights
- **X** Anything with an open flame (This includes candles & incense)
- **★** Pets (Except fish, with a 10 gallon size limit)
- **★** Weapons (Knives, paintball guns, BB guns, etc.)
- **★** Flammable liquids and/or substances
