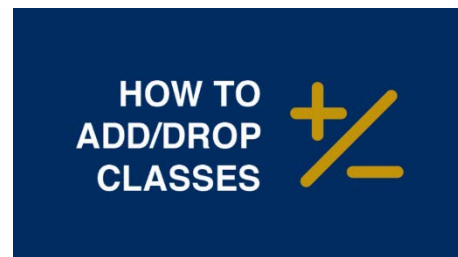
Add/Drop Process
