Add/Drop Process

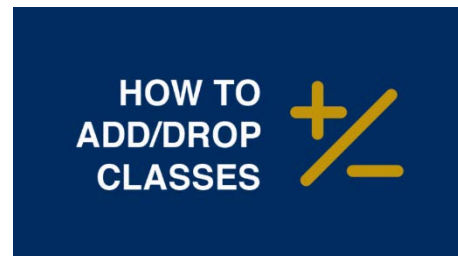
You may add or drop a course at any time during the term.
