

Poster submissions for the Honors Office to print your poster at due in less than two weeks on Monday, 11/17 at 4:30 pm.

Posters must be 24" x 36" and 300 DPI if a raster file. If the graphic is Vector, then no need to be concerned with DPI.

Printed posters will be distributed at check-in at the Symposium.

Please feel free to bring a non-Honors friend - all are welcome and there will be snacks!


