Alternative Break Honors Information Session

Are You Interested in Applying for a 2026 Alternative Break Immersion Trip?

The Alternative Break (AB) program gives students the opportunity to engage with and contribute to communities around the world. Students who participate spend a week learning about critical challenges facing communities, interacting with local leaders, and performing short-term projects with community agencies.

This information session led by the CLCE AB team will cover all questions Honors students may have about the program. All students interested in applying must attend an information session for the 2026 trips.

All trips cost \$675 and Honors students are given \$500 (this is not your honors grant) towards the cost of the trip. Students *can* use their honors grant to pay the \$175 deposit which will be reimbursed after the trip takes place.
