The age group a participant is in will significantly impact how they came to get their Jewish identity.




### Methods

#### Survey


- **Demographic questions**

  - **Imposter**




# Results Survey: 130 Participants








# **Analysis & Conclusion**

A lot of the data surrounding people's cultural identity wasn't statistically relevant, however there were a few outliers.



I was unable to find correlations between the time periods and the outliers (i.e. feelings of imposter syndrome, bar mitzvahs). I believe further qualitative research needs to be done to achieve clearer results.
