



STEP 1: Archive & Collect, STEP 2: Label & Organize, STEP 3: Create Layout & Template, STEP 4: Designation of Artworks, STEP 5: Add/Place Photos & Text, STEP 6: Proofread & Edit, STEP 7: Publish Site & Obtain URL
