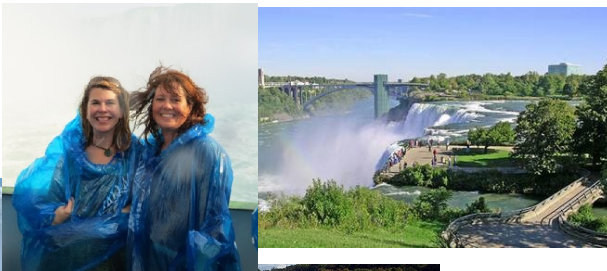
Niagara Falls Power Authority



- ◆ The Niagara Power Plant produces a steady supply of clean, carbon-free hydroelectricity.
- ◆ Located about 4 1/2 miles downstream from the Falls, consists of two main facilities each with 12 or 13 turbines. In between the two plants is a forebay capable of holding about 740 million gallons of water.
- ◆ Water is diverted from the Niagara River—up to 375,000 gallons a second—through the Robert Moses plant spins turbines that power generators, converting this mechanical energy into electrical energy.

- ◆ You WILL get wet!

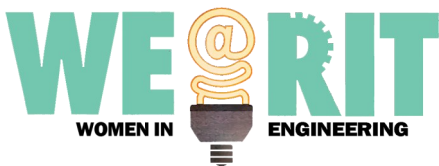
