Students may apply for short-term student loans in PCB for up to 12 months of loan maturity, and also for long-term loans up to 7 years (NLB Bank) with a grace period of up to 2 years.

General rules:

- If your semester tuition and fees payment is received no later than the 15th of June for the Fall semester and no later than the 1st of November for the Spring semester you will be categorized in an early bird registration and 50 Euro will be deducted from your Tuition and fees per semester.
- If your semester tuition and fees payment is received no later than the 1st of August for the Fall semester and not later than November 15th for the Spring semester you will be categorized in a regular registration plan.
- If your semester tuition and fees payment is received later than the 1st of August for the Fall semester and later than November 15th for the Spring semester you will be categorized in a late registration plan and an additional 100 Euro will be added to your Tuition and fees per semester.
- Students with outstanding dues will not be allowed to register until all dues have been settled.
- Early bird registration is not available if you choose a payment agreement such as a student's short-term or long-term loans or payment plan A.
- Early bird registration is not available to scholarship recipients.
- To students who chose payment plan A, a late registration fee will not be applied.

Payment Plan

- Payment plan requests need to be signed and submitted to the Finance Office. The form is available at <https://www.rit.edu/kosovo/financial-office#payment-information>).
- If you are on a payment plan, there are 2 installments due each semester. Each installment is 1/4 the tuition amount (subtracted by any scholarship awarded) due for the semester as stated above.
- If you are on a payment plan and are late or miss an installment, you will forfeit the opportunity to continue the payment plan and will be subject to regular payment conditions (full semester tuition payment without any discounts).

The following guidelines are used to determine individual tuition:

SOIS students

Full time:

- Tuition and fees for the regular registration category is 6,940.00€ which covers up to 120 required academic credits for completion of BS in SOIS degree.
- Full-time SOIS student is defined as any student that takes 12-15 credits per semester for the duration of their studies.
- The price for 1-semester credit for full-time students taking above 15 credits (per semester) is 275.00€.
- The price for 0 credit preparatory English and Math classes is equivalent to a 3-credit class.

Part-time:

- The price for 1-semester credit for part-time students is 330.00€, plus the student activity fee for part-time students is 10.00€ per semester.

CIT students

Full-time:

- Tuition and fees for the regular registration category are 6,940.00€ which covers up to 127 required academic credits for completion of BS in CIT degree. Full-time CIT Student is defined below:
 - Students enrolled in 12-17 credits in the Fall and/or Spring of their freshmen year.
 - Students enrolled in 12-18 credits in only one of the semesters of the remaining academic years.
 - Students enrolled in 12-15 credits in all other semesters of their academic years.
- The price for 1-semester credit for full-time students taking above the listed number of credits (per semester) is 275.00€.
- The price for 0 credit preparatory English and Math classes is equivalent to a 3-credit class.

Part-time:

- The price for 1-semester credit for a part-time student is 330.00€, plus the student activity fee for a part-time student is 10.00€ per semester.
