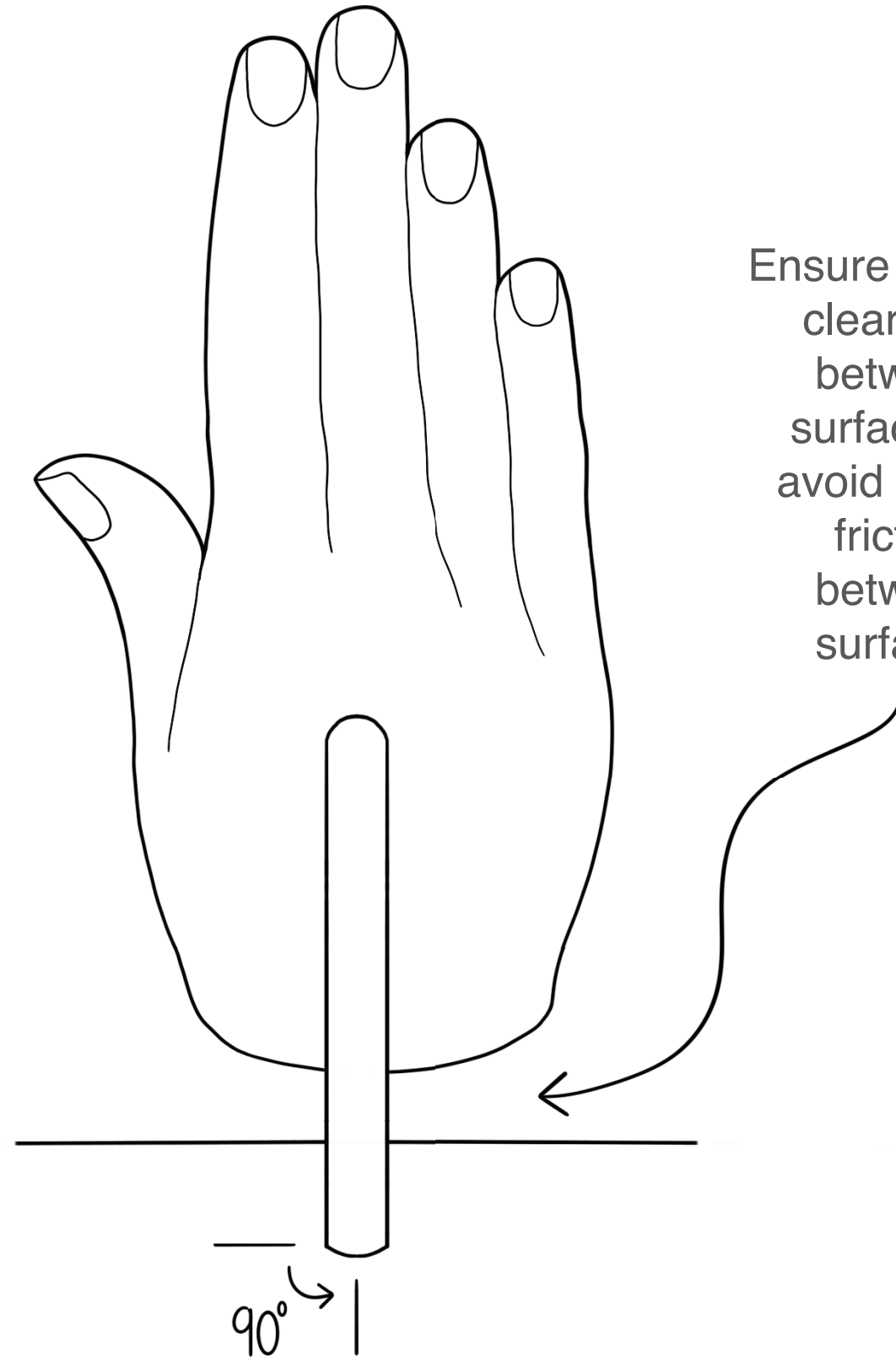




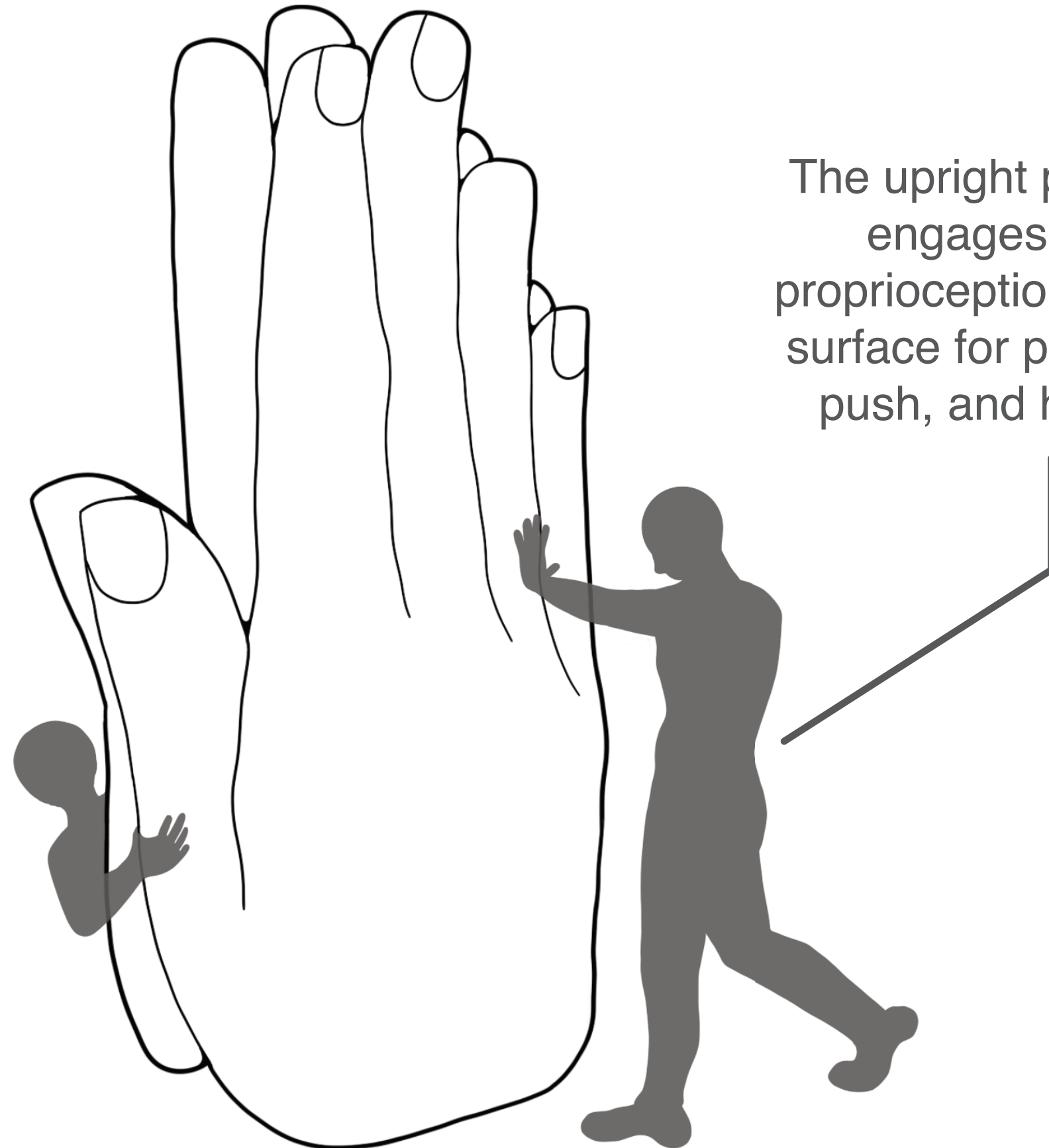




This pair of hands turns a maximum of 90° in reference to the beginning part of the ASL sign for “peace”
