### What is the RIT Faculty Senate?

- One of four shared governance bodies at RIT (<https://www.rit.edu/shared-governance>)
  1. Faculty Senate (FS)
  2. Staff Council (SC)
  3. Student Government (SG)
  4. University Council (UC);
    - includes FS, SC, SG, and Administration (President, Provost, etc.)
- **Advocates** for faculty in governance matters (e.g., at UC), creates and revises policy in co-operation with the Provost (Dr. Prabu David) and RIT Academic Affairs
- **Shares information** related to academic work and the working lives of faculty

### Some Suggestions
