Stages of the co-operation program

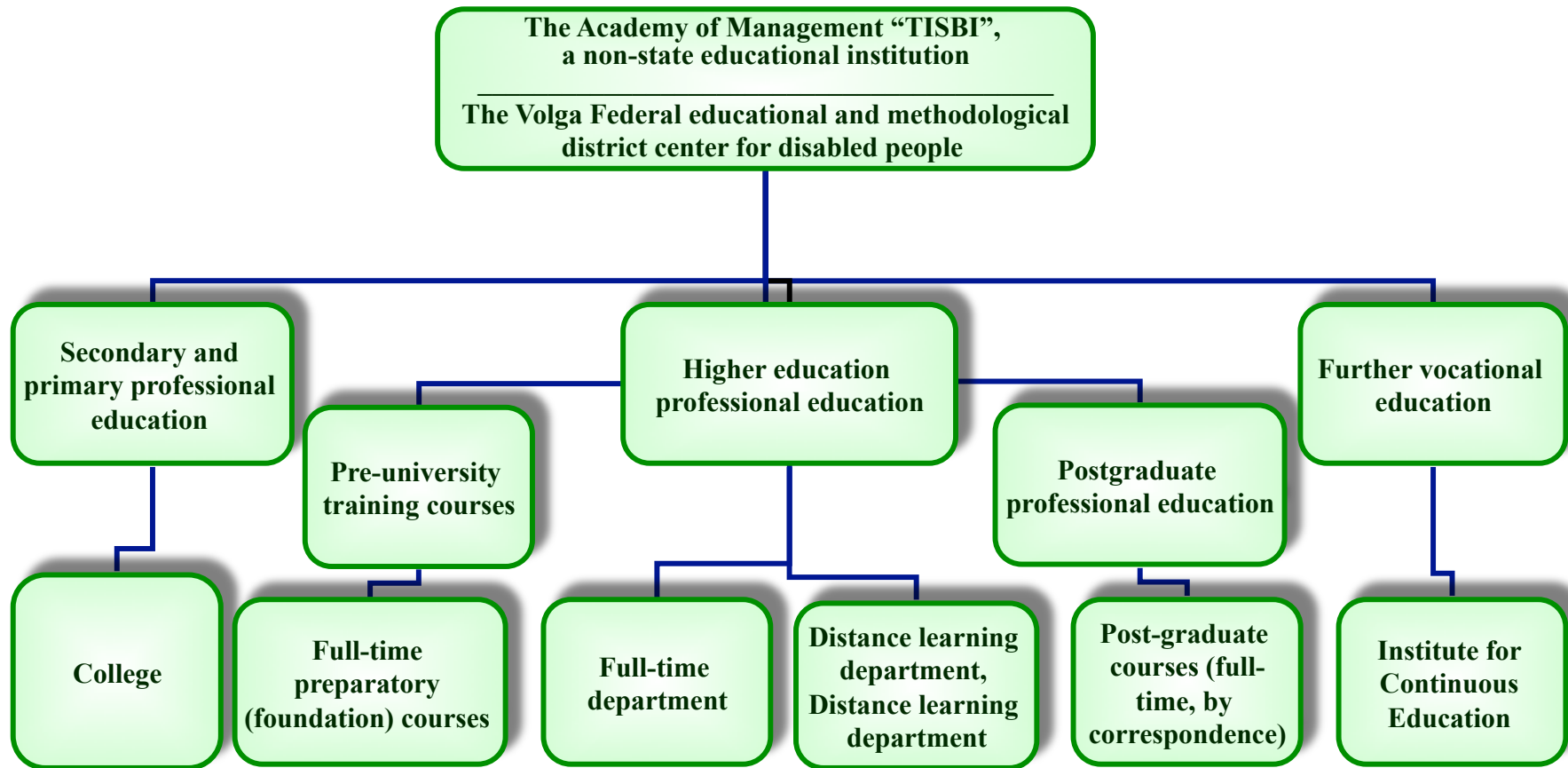


- c 1997 г.** – First 17 deaf students start studies according to the secondary professional education program.
- c 2004 г.** – Lecturers and sign language interpreters take training courses at Bauman state Technological University (Moscow).
 - The Academy of Management “TISBI” joins “Pen International” network.
- c 2005 г.** – Opening of the full-time faculty for deaf and-hard-of-hearing students according to higher education professional program (majoring at “Accounting”)
- c 2006 г.** – Opening of a special multi media class for teaching deaf students.
 - First deaf students graduate with higher school diplomas.
- c 2008 г.** – The government of the Republic of Tatarstan signed an agreement with “Pen International” foundation in the sphere of professional education and further employment of deaf people.
- c 2009 г.** – High School professional education – College professional education United educational space was formed



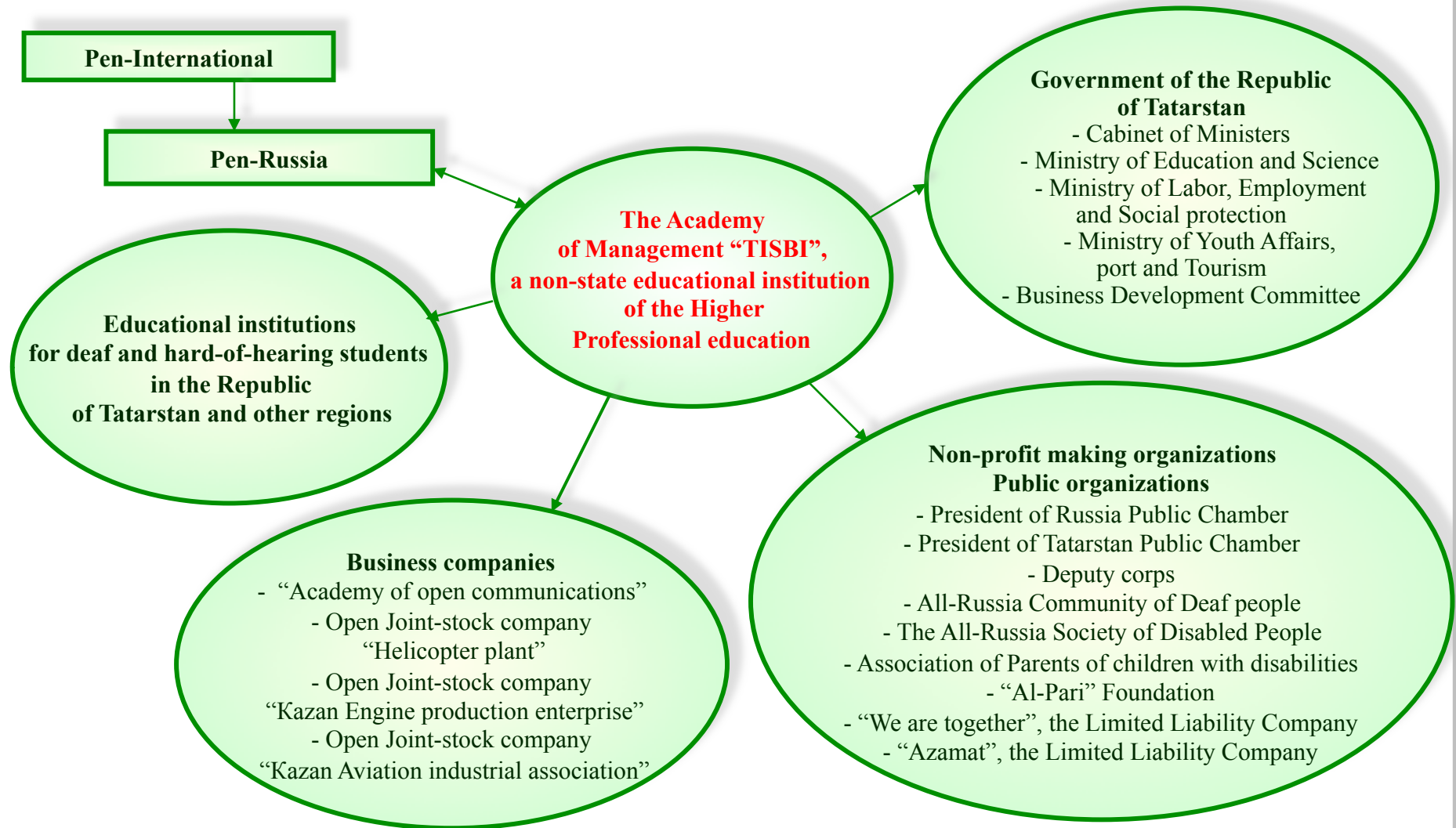


Life-long (Continuous) professional education of people with hearing impairment:

Educational process maintenance program

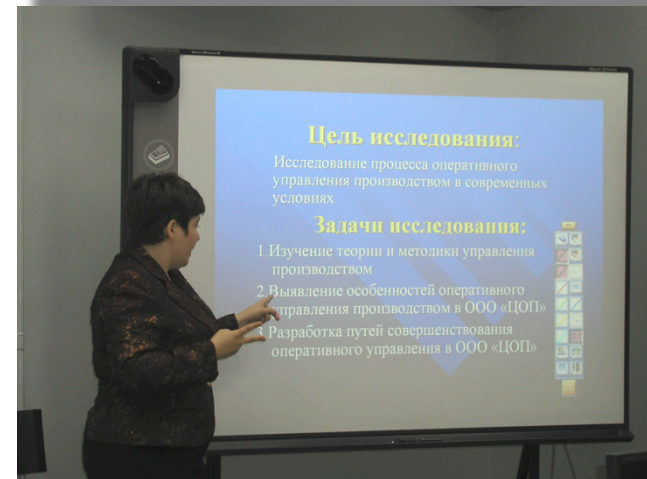


- *Organizational*

- *115 students graduated from the professional education program:*
 - *96 students graduated from secondary professional education programs.*
 - *19 students graduated from higher professional education programs.*

- *Now there are 243 students in the program:*
 - *60 students – according to secondary professional education programs.*
 - *183 students – according to higher professional education programs.*



- **The Academy of Management “TISBI” has formed and is effectively using the system of continuous professional education for deaf and hard-of-hearing students.**
- **The social status of deaf and hard-of-hearing students in the professional education program became higher.**
- **There is a necessity to consolidate the resources of state, business communities and public organizations to provide deaf and hard-of-hearing people with affordable high quality education.**

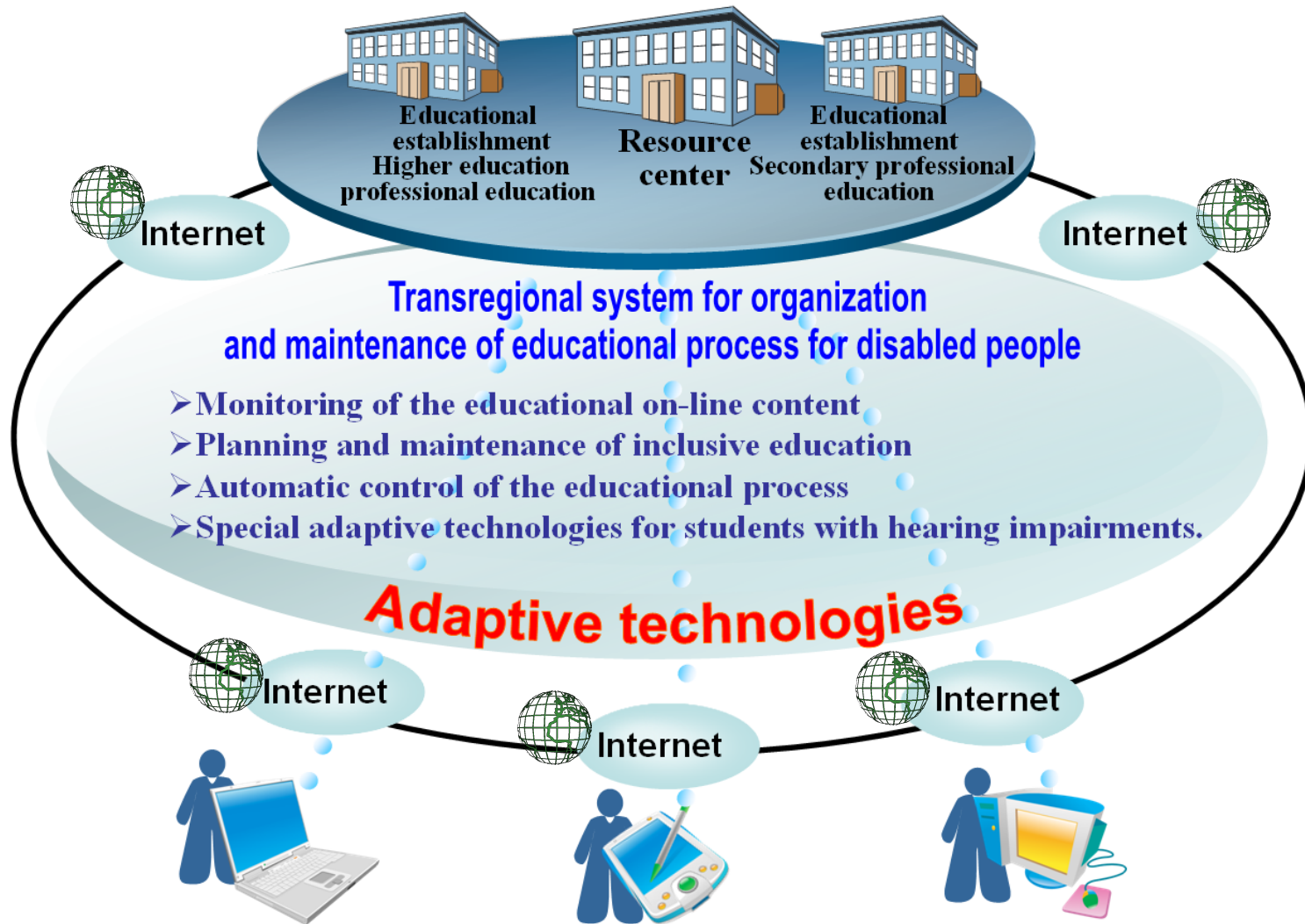
