

NTID International Declaration of Finance Form

U.S. government regulations require all non-U.S. citizens to demonstrate sufficient financial resources to meet the costs of tuition, fees, supplies and living expenses for at least nine months of full-time study before RIT may issue the I-20 (or DS-2019) and/or matriculate the student.

The total cost for two semesters of study at RIT/NTID for the 2023-2024 academic year is approximately \$60,000 USD for undergraduate study and approximately \$67,000 USD for graduate study.

See rit.edu/sfs/ntid-international for the 2023-2024 cost of attendance. The 2024-2025 cost will be posted in mid-March. There may be additional costs (i.e., health insurance, transportation, SEVIS fee) that are not reflected in the cost of attendance.

Applicants are considered for tuition-reduction scholarships based on financial need. Application requirements are found at rit.edu/ntid/admissions/international. A completed application along with the completed declaration of financial support form with supporting documents is the only way for RIT to determine eligibility for scholarships.
