Instructions for Completing the RIT/NTID International Declaration of Financial Support Form

The full cost of full-time, in-person study at RIT/NTID for the 2025-2026 academic year is approximately \$65,500 USD for undergraduate study and approximately \$74,000 USD for graduate study. This reflects the total considering all possible expenses (i.e., tuition, room/board, student fees, books/supplies, health insurance, orientation). Variable expenses such as books/supplies and orientation is estimated in the overall total and will be adjusted accordingly. Additional costs (i.e., transportation, SEVIS fee) are not reflected in the cost of attendance. See www.rit.edu/sfs/ntid-international for the 2025-2026 cost of attendance. The 2026-2027 cost will be posted in mid-March 2026.

Scholarships, based on financial need, for international students are available on a limited basis thus lowering the cost of attendance. The Declaration of Financial Support Form and supporting documents must be provided before RIT may confirm the actual cost of attendance and determine eligibility for the limited number of available scholarships. Applicants who are clearly unable to cover the cost of attendance with or without scholarships may be withdrawn if it is determined RIT cannot meet your assumed need.

Financial documents cannot be older than six months to the date of the completed RIT application. Bank statements must verify liquid funds (checking/savings accounts). Term/Fixed deposits are allowed if the documents indicate a current maturity date and/or a statement confirming the funds are accessible any time.
