The Workforce Recruitment Program (WRP) provides students and recent graduates with disabilities with career development and potential internships and jobs in the Federal Government.

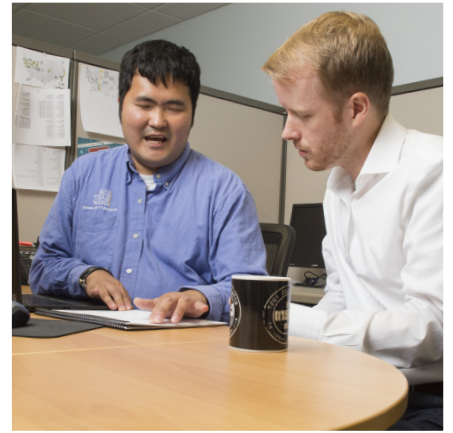
- **Gain** interviewing experience
