Chair's Report – Brian Trager

- 1. Communication Officer Update
 - 1. Minutes from last minutes approved.
 - A. 8 Voted YES and 1 Abstained
- 2. Professor of Practice (POP)
 - A. RIT set up general purpose of this to fit each college and each college will write the job description based on college needs.
 - B. This position is for up to five years, possible renewable for an additional five years based on needs of department.
 - C. Some concern about the policy and the requirement for sign language as it states ADVANCED. Nervous that the language might scare away some candidates?
 - Discussion: Candidates will be expected to have advanced in SLPI but not required other factors will be looked at as well. Reason it's advanced is because it's a short-term position – not long term. Want them to "hit the road running"
 - 2. Also its not really a position that is open to the public it is more if a department or institute really has their eye on someone not like a position on Career Zone for everybody to apply.
 - D. Teaching is primary responsibility but not necessarily in the classroom.
 - E. The chair is the one who makes the request for the POP position.
