I understand that I am required to work under the SURF program full-time for ten (10) weeks during the Summer term.

If I need to withdraw from the SURF Program, I will notify my mentor and Dr. Todd Pagano (tepnts@rit.edu). Further, I am aware that any stipends received under this program will stop under these circumstances.
