### **Sunday - August 9th, 2026 9am to 1pm Move In Required**

RIT hosts several Orientation programs with different move in dates. Students attending our NTID Summer Vestibule Program are scheduled to move in on August 9th.

All SVP students are required to arrive, check in, and pick up their key and ID during this time. If you have any known foreseeable conflicts, please contact our office as soon as possible so we can work with you.

### **Monday - August 10th, 2026 9am to 6pm Parent & Family Orientation Highly encouraged**

NTID will offer a variety of events such as Service Fair where staff members from various departments across campus will be available to answer questions and provide resources.

NTID faculty & staff will introduce themselves and be available to answer questions during both our Academic Affairs & Student Affairs panel.

### **Tuesday - August 11th, 2026 9am SVP Begins**

**Students must attend ALL required programs during SVP. Students will receive a copy of the schedule upon checking in on Move In Day which will indicate required events, and optional events.**

During SVP, we will provide a series of workshops which have been carefully tailored to help give our incoming students tools they need to navigate through their first year here on campus. These workshops will touch on a series of topics such as resources offered, how to advocate for themselves during their time here, tips & strategies to help them tackle common situations, and many other key topics.

Prior to August 9th, the SVP team will be working closely with students to make sure they're able to complete everything on their new student checklist before they arrive on campus.
