

Objective 31:

The student should be able to use a relaxed voice to produce five-syllable meaningful utterances (all syllables beginning with /w/, /b/, /d/, /p/, /t/, /l/, /f/ or a vowel) on one exhalation.

Exercise 57:

Note to Student:

In this exercise, you will be reading five-word phrases. All of the words will start with /w/, /b/, /d/, /p/, /t/, /l/, /f/ or a vowel. Listen and watch as I say the phrase. Repeat it after me. Concentrate on saying all five words with a relaxed voice and on one breath of air. After you read the phrase, check on the paper if you were able to say the phrase with a relaxed voice.

Note to Therapist:

If student uses tension when producing a particular phoneme, loop back to the phrase exercise for that phoneme. If student seems to become tense at the end of a phrase, regardless of phoneme, provide instruction in the control of air expenditure for speech. When possible, encourage the student to blend phonemes and use a normal rate of articulation. Sixty phrases comprise this exercise. The student should produce as many phrases as necessary to stabilize relaxed production of five-word utterances. When student exhibits this skill, test for criterion on twenty unpracticed phrases. If desired, additional phrases, everyday expressions, or conversational exchanges may be practiced to further enhance the student's development of a self-monitored relaxed voice.

Criterion:

The student demonstrates that 80% of the time he can use a relaxed voice to produce five-word phrases (all words beginning with /w/, /b/, /d/, /p/, /t/, /l/, /f/ or a vowel) on one breath of air, and 90% of the time he can correctly evaluate his performance.
