The Women's Council of RIT offers many member benefits. It is a great way to meet new people and to learn about a variety of issues at their luncheon events. Women's Council members can also take college courses (either graduate or under graduate, including online courses) auditable for free, with permission from the faculty or chair person. Members can also receive a 10% discount at Barnes and Noble.

To make full use of these benefits, you need to show proof of membership. Free digitized ID cards are available from the Registrar's office.

The procedures for getting your ID cards are outlined below:

1. You will need a photo ID, a driver's license or passport as identification.

3. Location: Registrar's Office, George Eastman Hall (Building 1)

Directions are as follows:

1. Drive to the campus information booth.
2. Get a Visitor's Parking Pass.
3. Park in the Visitor's Parking lot. Handicapped Parking is available.
4. Best time to visit is between 2:00 pm and 3:30 pm.
5. ** If you have challenges and need to park closer, let them know at the information booth. They will direct you to the closest parking spot.
