

SAMPLE APPLICATION 2026 Eisenhart Award for Excellence in Faculty Mentoring

- 1. A full-time RIT faculty member who has been in a mentee relationship with an RIT faculty member may nominate their mentor. The nominee must **not** be in a position of authority over the mentee, e.g. their department head or dean. Groups of mentees may nominate a single mentor.
- 2. To nominate a faculty mentor, complete and submit the nomination form, https://rit.az1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_0vwWpkCQ9XmnF1s (Qualtrics). (You are now on of the nomination form sample.)

It is strongly recommended that the nomination application be prepared in a Word document, then copy to the Qualtrics form.

- 4. Please note that this award is for faculty-to-faculty mentoring, not faculty-student mentoring.
