In keeping with RIT's academic oversight principles regarding openness in scholarship related to externally sponsored activity (policy C01.0), it is necessary for Principal Investigators to seek approval from their academic departments when accepting externally sponsored projects that request a restriction to publications stemming from their efforts.

This form provides academic units with pertinent information necessary to make informed decisions regarding publication restrictions and to protect the academic freedoms of RIT and its faculty, staff, and students participating in externally sponsored activities.
