Student Government Budget Overview - Kate Seeman

NEW BUSINESS

- Student Government Initiatives & Project, President Rafael Gilboa
 - These are the projects we will be presented to University Council to share with the university
 - Spring Club Fair
 - Hoping to have a second club fair in the Spring, similar to the fall club fair
 - Funding is an issue for the fall
 - Questions:
 - X-Reg: when do you plan to host this?
 - Pres: Similar to the fall club here it would likely be sometime in the first week. Hosting it at a consistent time would help with attendance and students showing up
 - On-campus jobs career fair
 - Many options to work on campus to share these opportunities to the students. This would also help see what benefits are offered to other similar jobs to drive interest and benefits
 - Questions
 - OUTSpoken will the supervisors of the jobs be in attendance
 - Yes, that's the plan
 - COLA We should have financial aid table to help students decide how this affects their aid
 - SOIS Professors should also be invited to help staff TA positions
 - Downtown Bus
 - Student Affairs used to pay the bus company we worked with to have a bus go downtown every weekend. Potentially partnering with CAB for an event based downtown bus. Students pay less to go downtown. If there is good data/numbers we can pitch to SA to bring back the bus
 - Questions

- · Greek: What do you mean by event based
 - Pres: This week this time we advocate to CAB not necessarily based on events but the bus would be an event
- 2-week Add/Drop
 - Hoping to move to ten days to add and drop from a class
 - Questions
 - Women's pushback because we would have to explain add drop and the day after add drop is when students can get their financial aid refunds if they have. This would need to be explained to students from an add drop perspective and financial

 - Have Senators table in a common space for their college alongside other SG members

 - More accessible website for students and SG to have more functions
