
## **Mutual Resolution Agreement Process**

## **Title IX Investigation**

<u>Title IX Office</u> completes their investigation and issues a Final Investigative Report (FIR) to the **Student Conduct Office**.

## **Mutual Resolution Agreement (MRA) Process**

- Student Conduct reviews the FIR and determines if the case qualifies for an MRA
- Student Conduct reaches out to students to explain the MRA
- Students consider whether or not to pursue the MRA



Signed MRA is considered

final and cannot be appealed

Both students accept decision

and MRA Outcome Letter

A Mutual Resolution Agreement is considered a Formal Resolution, not an Informal Resolution, because it occurs after an investigation has occurred and formal charges have been assigned.
