Dubrovnik or Zagreb, Croatia

Siena School for Liberal Arts - Deaf Studies

Siena, Italy

Affiliate Program, Summer

This three-week program allows signers an opportunity to engage in the Italian Deaf community. Expand your knowledge of both the diversity and commonality of Deaf communities globally. Classes are taught in ASL. Take courses in Italian Sign Language and Italian Deaf Culture & History.

No previous Italian language required. Must be fluent in ASL.

Access Services

Meet with your Academic Advisor to determine the timing and coursework that will work best for you.

VR Support

Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) services may provide financial assistance to NTID students studying abroad. Ask your VR counselor to determine if assistance is available.

Funding
