Notes

A) Tuition for 6 credits

B) Housing will be in shared apartments, double rooms.

C) Program fees may include cultural visits, bus pass (if applicable), wi-fi access at program center, farewell dinner, etc.

D) The RIT Administrative program fee is charged on all external RIT study abroad programs to recover the administrative costs associated with these programs. In an effort to keep affiliate programs affordable, the fee is charged in lieu of RIT tuition. The funds associated with the fees are used to support students and faculty in the development of RIT goals for international education.

E) The participation confirmation deposit is non-refundable, and is NOT a traditional deposit and will not be debited from tuition or other costs. It is paid directly to Siena and will not appear on the RIT SFS student account.

F) Siena will offer optional program activities throughout the duration of the program. Some examples include a hiking trip (5 euro), medieval festival (15 euro) and day trips to surrounding cities (25 euros).

G) Student should budget more if they intend to travel on weekends.
