

Vera G. Pirogova is the head of the sign-language laboratory at the Center for the Deaf students at Bauman Moscow State Technical University (BMSTU). She studied at the Leningrad Rehabilitation Centre of All-Russian Society of the Deaf and at the department of advanced sign-language training for the deaf at the Ukrainian Society of the Deaf. She worked as a sign-language interpreter in Kiev, as the head of studies and then as the director of the Professional Development and Training Centre for Sign-Language Interpreters in Kiev. In addition, Vera participated in writing several books on sign-language and speech for the deaf in Ukraine. When she moved to Moscow, she worked at the Central Administration of All-Russian Society of the Deaf, and at a medical college where deaf students were studying. Since 1994, she has been working at Bauman Moscow State Technical University. Her parents being deaf, she attended classes for the deaf at a club and mastered sign language as a child. She is very much experienced in sign-language processes in educational settings.
