

Division of Rehabilitation Services

Division of Rehabilitation has been established to approach various fields of rehabilitation such as education for the handicapped, vocational rehabilitation, social psychological rehabilitation, rehabilitation engineering, chirology, and to develop specialists. This division, authorized as a specialist by the Ministry of Education, has been studying research focusing on rehabilitation.

Human Rehabilitation

Human Rehabilitation is a major established by KNU. Based on the spirit of Christianity, the major plans to train specialists who help the handicapped adjust to society and to support them in terms of education, vocation, and mental state.

Curriculum is made up of academic research on vocation, psychology, education, social rehabilitation and practical experiences linked with actual field services. According to the aptitude of the students, this major offers specialized courses for vocational rehabilitation, welfare for the disabled, rehabilitation treatment, etc. to equip the students for practical knowledge.

After completion, students can acquire vocational rehabilitator, vocational educator, social worker, drawing curer, and make inroads to all kinds of welfare centers, vocational rehabilitation organizations, special schools and nursing homes.

Rehabilitation Engineering

Gom Woo Hoe is the only sport-oriented association that incorporates people of Hae Dong Gom Do (Korean type of swordsmanship). It started in 1995, but the KNU organization

formed in 1996. Gom Woo Hoe is an energetic and fun-loving club, which trains not only in swordsmanship itself but also in the art and philosophy of swordsmanship. We always try to ensure that people are having fun as well as learning. If you are interested in the club, please visit us to observe how we practice. You are always welcome!

Language Treatment

Language Treatment aims to raise language treatment specialists who can improve the ability of communication of people who have all kinds of disorders in speaking and listening. Since KNU was a recognized leader of the NURI Project in 2004, the major has reinforced its faculty, facilities and other learning conditions.

Curriculum focuses on systematic learning by theory and practice. This project has been operating language treatment centers in Seoul and CheonAn, which allows the students to practice in real life situations.

Successful graduates are expected to acquire language curer, special teacher for treatment, and employment at welfare centers, rehabilitation facilities, hospitals, special schools and nursing homes.

Sign Language Translation

Sign Language Translation was established to develop experts who are able to translate sign languages as well as being able to deal with rehabilitation welfare matters for the sake of the people who have hearing difficulties. Students are trained to be specialists who can translate at home and abroad.

Multi-track type of study will help the student improve their specialties. The 3 tracks are regular, special and teacher? course with detailed classes for each track. The Regular track trains students for professional rehabilitation welfare servant. The Special track trains students to become sign language translators, translators for people with hearing difficulty, and hearing aid producers. The Teacher? Course includes sign language translator training and educational translator. Students thus can achieve authorized sign language translator, social welfare servant and treatment recreation technician. With these qualifications graduates are welcome not only in a wide variety of facilities that need these experts urgently, but also in regular business, tour guides, and academy for chirology.
